## 2023 Presidents Report

On Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June we held the Winter Rewards finals day at Central Southland Raceway, we will be hosting this again in the upcoming season with some good money on offer.

The new Café/Coffee room has been well received and is a great asset to the venue. Thanks to Nola and Raylene and their helpers.

The improvements on course have continued this year. A full track resurface was undertaken in August 2022, a new water tanker was purchased in December 2022, we contributed towards a safety glass project in the north grandstand, this grandstand has also been partially re-roofed, we have upgraded the members/sponsors bar, helped towards the cost of replacing the steel windows with aluminium in the members grandstand and this whole building has also been repainted.
